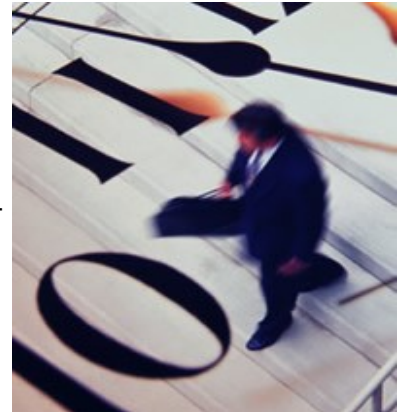


Business Management
