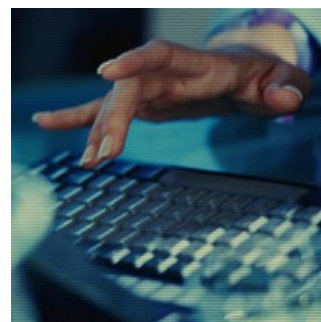


Associate of Science Degree
