Our Associate of Arts degrees are designed for students who plan to transfer to a four-year institution. These programs provide most of the general education classes you need for a four-year degree, allowing you to complete the first two years of a degree in a small school environment.

An Associate of Arts degree engages you in experiences that fosters intellectual, cultural, personal, professional, and ethical development.

Education
